The Challenge

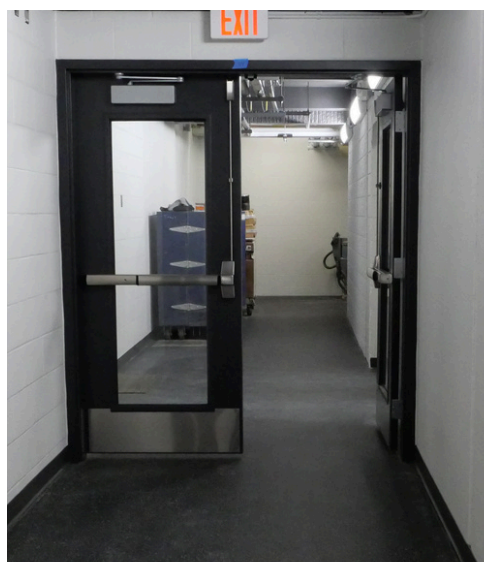

The scale of the glass and framing created logistical challenges, including the need for additional manpower and precise coordination. In addition, the project scope included both interior and exterior borrowed lites installed within hollow metal frames, requiring accuracy and attention to detail to ensure a clean, finished look.
